ITEM 9. OTHER MATTERS: GMA Network Marketing Head to retire by yearend

GMA Network announced that its Marketing and Productions president Manuel P. Quiogue will retire at the end of the year.

Quiogue, who has been with GMA Network since 2002, is a key figure in the company's phenomenal rise to the top in sales and revenues.

GMA Network Chairman President and CEO Felipe L. Gozon acknowledged Quiogue's valuable contributions to the company's growth. "It would be very difficult to find a replacement for Mr. Quiogue. He has contributed much to GMA Network's success," Gozon said.

Quiogue thanked GMA Network for acknowledging his contributions to the company. "I thank GMA for allowing me to play a role in the company's triumphs in the past few years. The past eight (8) years have seen a big change in the way TV advertising has evolved and I take some pride in that GMA has always been a catalyst in this evolution," Quiogue said.

Quiogue's successful sales and marketing career includes working in all three legs of advertising – on the agency side, the client side, and media. Among others, he worked for Carnation, J. Walter Thompson, Unilever, Levi Strauss, Coca Cola, and ABS-CBN prior to joining GMA Network. Quiogue was also the president of PANA in 1983, and became the Chairman of the Advertising Board of the Philippines the following year.

He was the Agora award winner for Outstanding Achievement in Marketing Management in 2003 and was the CEO EXCEL Award winner in the 2008 Communication Excellence in Organizations conducted by the International Association of Business Communicators.

Quiogue is currently a member of the Board of the Philippine Center for Population and Development, a member of the Board of Trustees of the Advertising Foundation of the Philippines, as well as the Board of Trustees of the Southeast Asia Foundation for Children's Television.

GMA Network has formed a search committee tasked to find a replacement for Quiogue. Quiogue is part of the search committee. (30)
